JULY 3RD CELEBRATION TRAFFIC FLOW PLAN

The City of Grove continues to improve the traffic flow in and out of the Wolf Creek Park for the July 3rd Celebration. Grove Police Officers, VIPS and Emergency Management personnel will be directing traffic at designated Traffic Control Points (TCP) as indicated on the map.

- **AVOID THE TRAFFIC AND BE TREATED LIKE A VIP, RIDE THE FREE AIR-CONDITIONED SHUTTLES**

To and from Wolf Creek on July 3rd

Shuttles will have a designated route on 16th Street and will receive priority entrance/exit into Wolf Creek Park. Pick up at Grove Civic Center between 5:30 – 8:30 p.m. Return to Grove Civic Center following Fireworks Show

- **DESIGNATED ROUTES** - Beginning at 5 p.m.
 16th Street will be designated for shuttles and emergency vehicles ONLY;
 21st Street will be designated for general traffic
- **PARKING SPACES LIMITED AT WOLF CREEK** When the Wolf Creek Parking Lot reaches capacity, no other vehicles will be allowed into the park, except shuttles and emergency vehicles.
- **PARKING PROHIBITED ON 16TH & 21ST STREET;**
- **EXIT ROUTE** - Following Fireworks display all vehicles except shuttles will be directed to 21st Street to Exit Wolf Creek Park. 21st Street will have two one-way west bound exit lanes. Vehicles turning left (south) will be allowed to enter Hwy 59 in the south bound lane. To turn right (north) onto Hwy 59 vehicles use the exit lane located on the north (aka Dollar General) side.
