## FREE AND SAFE DISPOSAL OF POLLUTANTS SUCH AS:

Motor oil, antifreeze, brake fluids, gasoline, oil-based paints,\* solvents, thinners, pesticides, weed killers, yard-care products, poisons, all types of batteries, household cleaners, drain openers, mercury, fluorescent bulbs, glues.

\* Latex paint is not hazardous and is discouraged at the collection event.  
To dispose of latex paint, solidify by air-drying and discard in curbside trash.

## UNACCEPTABLE:

Pressurized gas cylinders, medical wastes, pharmaceuticals, ammunition, other explosives or unknowns. All pollutants must be from city households or other residential customers of Grove Municipal Services Authority. Commercial and agricultural waste CANNOT be accepted.

**NOTE: Each car must show a current utilities bill from the Grove Muni. Services Authority**

## WASTE TIRES ALSO ACCEPTED FROM ANY DELAWARE COUNTY RESIDENT:

Passenger car, pickup, large truck tires, and tractor tires accepted.  
(Limit: 25 tires per household)  
NO tire dealers, NO tires on metal rims.
