## A REMINDER TO GROVE RESIDENTS REGARDING YARD DEBRIS BEING PICKED UP

If the Spring Clean-Up Crews have been by your residence, and did not pick up yard debris, branches, limbs, trees and stumps, it is because the size of the items are too large for the crews to pick up and too large to fit into the truck.

Residents are encouraged to follow the requirements of disposing of yard debris as follows:

- ✓ Grass clippings and leaves must be bagged
- Other Yard Debris must be bundled and tied with degradable string or twine. Materials larger than four (4) inches in diameter or four (4) feet in length will NOT BE PICKED UP.

The Spring Clean-up Crews are tracking the addresses where items too large to pick up have been left at the curbside. Residents will have the opportunity to bag, bundle and cut their yard debris to an acceptable size.

The crews will make a second attempt on Thursday (4/20) and Friday (4/21) to pick up the yard debris that was not picked up on the first round. If yard debris meets the size, bagging and bundling requirements the crews will pick it up.

HOUSEHOLD TRASH WILL NOT BE PICKED UP BY THE SPRING CLEAN-UP CREWS; A SEPARATE TRUCK WILL PICK UP HOUSEHOLD TRASH ON YOUR REGULAR PICK UP DAY.
