Don't be left holding the Bag!

To assure items will be picked up; residents may place items at the curbside beginning April 9

- ✓ Crews are not allowed to go onto private property; all items must be placed along the street in the city's right-of-way.
- ✓ Crews are not responsible for picking up items that are not in place when they stop for pick up.
- ✓ Junk, appliances, electronics, computers, tvs, furniture and yard debris will be accepted
- ✓ Yard debris must be properly bundled or bagged or it will not be picked up
 - Grass clippings/leaves must be bagged;
 - Other yard debris must be bundled and tied with degradable string or twine;
 - Bundle size is limited to a maximum size of 4' dimension and 4' length, materials *larger will be excluded from pick up*
- ✓ Household garbage will be collected on regular trash service day, and will not be picked up with the Spring Clean-Up items.

ITEMS EXCLUDED FROM PICK UP: Tires – Batteries – Motor Oil – Paint products such as paint, varnish, thinner; pressurized gas cylinders, medical wastes, pharmaceuticals, ammunition, and other explosives.

FREE & SAFE DISPOSAL OF PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS

Don't take a chance of your children or grandchildren having access to your un-used medications. Safely dispose of them at the Grove Police Department, 13 E 3rd Street; disposal box is available inside the lobby 24 hrs/7days.
