SUMMARY

Lifeguards shall be responsible for monitoring pool patrons in a manner that provides a safe environment. Lifeguards shall perform safe water rescues, CPR and First Aid as needed.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Monitor pool patrons in a manner that provides a safe environment
- Provide safe water rescues, CPR and First Aid as needed
- Perform cleaning and concession duties as assigned
- Enforcement of pool policies, rules and regulations
- Perform other duties as assigned

PERIPHERAL DUTIES

 Abides by all standards, conduct and policies, as stated in the Personnel Policy and Procedural Manual

The duties listed above are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.

SAFETY SENSITIVE POSITION

This position is a 'Safety Sensitive' position as defined by the United States Department of Transportation and alcohol testing regulations, the Oklahoma Standards for Workplace Drug and Alcohol Testing Act and/or Oklahoma Medical Marijuana laws. As a "Safety Sensitive" classification, you will be subject to drug and alcohol testing, including random testing. Marijuana is one of the substances included in the drug panel screening. Possession of a Medical Marijuana License will not excuse you

from the testing process, or the consequences of testing positive for marijuana. This position performs the following Safety Sensitive Duties:

- Provides life-saving CPR and First Aid Training to lifeguards
- This positive provides life saving CPR and First Aid to swimmers and guests at the pool
- This position uses hazardous chemicals that require safety procedures be properly followed to prevent damage to both property and person.

- Minimum of 16 years of age

Physical

- Has ability to provide safety rescues as needed
- Has ability to provide CPR and First Aid as needed
- Has normal eyesight and depth perception, with or without correction
- Hears normal tones, with or without correction

Cognitive

- Ability to listen, understand, read, write and communicate information
- Ability to communicate effectively using audio system
- Ability to work with the general public in a professional manner
