City of Grove New Curbside Collection Program

YOUR SERVICE DAY WILL REMAIN THE SAME!

CARDS is proud to announce the new curbside collection program for residents of Grove, OK. This is an informational tool to help you understand the services that CARDS will be providing. We strongly encourage you to read and retain this information for future reference.

Beginning July 1, 2022, CARDS will provide curbside collection for all residences. Under the new curbside collection program each customer will receive a new 96-gallon cart for trash collected once a week at the curbside. These containers are provided at no additional cost. Upon receiving the carts, residents will roll the containers to the end of the driveway or designated pickup location on collection day. Collection day will remain the same, and a map of each service day will be posted on the City Website and Facebook page.

To make the program successful, the remainder of this information will outline important guidelines for you to follow when using the services available. This will ensure that you receive the best possible service with as little inconvenience as possible. **Upon receiving the carts, you may begin using them starting July 1, 2022.**

COLLECTION PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

- Trash must be curbside by 5:00 a.m. on your designated collection day.
- All trash must be contained in the cart issued by CARDS so that the lid is closed to be collected.
- The 96-gallon containers will hold up to 150 pounds. Please do not overload the container.
- Yard Waste shall be placed in the poly cart if there is room, if not, yard waste may be placed outside the container; leaves, plants, grass and clippings must be bagged; limbs, branches and bushes must be bundled with degradable string or twine and no items over four (4) inches in diameter or four (4) feet in length.
- The carts remain the property of CARDS and will be maintained by CARDS. Residents will be required to pay for replacement of any container if the damage is due to their negligence or abuse. **Do not take the container with you when you move.**

Items that **CANNOT** be placed in the **trash** container: Dirt, sod, concrete, rock, construction or demolition debris, household hazardous waste, banned electronic waste, animal carcasses, hot ashes, or flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint, batteries, engine parts or tires.

SAFE USE AND CARE OF CART:

- O Always keep the lid closed to keep rain, snow, and animals out.
- O Use the handle provided to move the cart. Tilt cart on wheels and roll.
- o To clean, simply rinse with water from time to time and let dry in the sunlight with the lid open.
- O Do not place any unacceptable materials in the cart.

For those needing an additional cart, please call CARDS and one can be provided for an additional fee of \$84.00 per year.

PLEASE NOTE: When a holiday falls on a weekday, collection will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week. If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay.
