Notice is hereby given that the Grove Municipal Services Authority will receive sealed bids in the Office of the Clerk at the Grove Municipal Building, 104 W 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Oklahoma 74344, up to 10:00 a.m. on December 7, 2023, for furnishing all labor and materials and performing all work necessary for:

The project consists of point repairs, line replacement, manhole rehabilitation and other appurtenances.

All questions are due by December 1, 2023, at 12:00 p.m.

Bidders must bid on all items of the contract. The whole work under this contract will be awarded as a single contract to the lowest responsible bidder for the work. No bid may be withdrawn for at least sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a Bidder's Bond, or Cashier's Check upon any solvent Bank or Trust Company, payable without reserve to the Grove Municipal Services Authority, Grove, Oklahoma, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. Bid security of the two low bidders will be retained until approval of contract and execution of satisfactory bonds by the successful bidder, or until other disposition on the bids is made.

BIDDER must purchase plans and specifications from Holloway, Updike and Bellen, Inc. either directly for a hard copy of bidding documents or through Quest CDN for an electronic copy. Bidder must be on the Engineer's official plan holder's list in order to receive addendums and submit a bid.

The bonds required will be a Performance Bond, a Payment Bond, and a Maintenance Bond, each in the full amount of the contract. The City will not accept letters of credit in lieu of any bond required herein.

Each bidder must have such information, together with a recent financial statement, available upon request.
