Summary of the Law



 Call 48 hours before you dig.
Emergencies must be called in as soon as possible.



Wait the required amount of time

- Call at least two days, but no more than 10 days excluding Sat. & Sun. and legal holidays prior to excavation.
- Member utilities will mark the approximate location of their facilities within 48 hours or communicate to the excavators they have no facilities in the proposed excavation site.

Respect the marks

- Update your request if work is not started within 10 working days or if marks are no longer visible.
- The safety zone is a strip of land two (2) feet on either side of the underground facility. Remember to include the width of the facility!



Dig with care

- If digging within the safety zone, you must determine the precise location of the underground facility by digging test holes by hand.
- In case damage occurs, notify the operators of the underground facilities immediately! If the damage permits the escape of hazardous gas or liquid, you must also notify the police and the fire department immediately.
- Excavators must delay backfilling in the damage area until repairs are made.

Short list of required information for the call center

- Work date and time
- Type of work
- Excavator company and caller contact information
- County, city (or nearest town if rural)
- Specific directions to the work site and nearest intersection
- Who is the work being done for
- Duration of work
